Supply list: Literature book, paper no larger than 12x18, no smaller than 8 x 11, pencil/pen, crayons, markers, or colored pencils, ruler, imagination and concentration.

Some students have done their maps on the computer, but if you aren't familiar with draw and paint programs, you will be frustrated and may not finish on time. It is highly recommended that you create a rough draft. It is very difficult to erase markers or crayons.

Your finished project will be a map of Ship Trap Island, developed for tourists who visit the island while on Caribbean cruises. Include the following items:

Compass rose

Scale

Point in the Caribbean Sea where Rainsford went overboard

The beach where Rainsford landed

Zaroff's chateau

Rainsford's route as he was being pursued from the chateau

The tree where Rainsford spent his first night

Death Swamp

Maylay man-catcher trap

Burmese tiger pit

Ugandan trap

Rainsford's route as he made his way back to the chateau

Any other points of interest for tourists (places where people died, etc.)

Indicate the terrain with artwork or standard map-making patterns.

You may want to include a gift shop, restaurant, or cabins for overnight.
